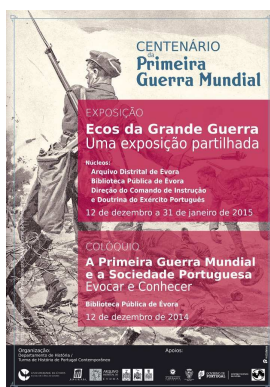

Nowadays, the Catholic Church, to name just one of the bigger religious persuasions, has its largest base of support in countries of the formerly so-called 'Third World.' Consequently, there seems to be a close connection between religion and poverty, especially in the 21st century, when the hope for a better afterlife has become a driving force of the poor population of the world. However, what could be interpreted as a proof of the Marxist doctrine of religion as opium of the people, for sure deserves a more multi-perspectival approach, which would not just cover the recent years of human history, but past

centuries as well as the different religions around the globe. The interrelationship between religion and poverty is a very old one and is traceable through many expressions in art, literature, movies, and several other media. Consequently, the actual call for papers for the second volume of Global Humanities is asking for actual research that deals with this special relationship.

Topics might include but are not limited to:

- specific case studies in all fields of the humanities that are covering the two factors

The Woolf Institute, which specializes in the study of relations between Jews, Christians and Muslims from a multidisciplinary perspective, invites applications for its annual visiting fellowship.

The Fellowship is tenable for a two to three month period that overlaps one of the Cambridge terms 2016:

Lent term: 12 January–11 March 2016

Easter term: 19 April–10 June 2016

The successful candidate will be expected to be involved in a project of academic research, public education or of the arts in an area relevant to the Institute's work. The Fellow will be asked to present their work at a symposium on the subject of their project proposal.

There is no stipend attached to the Fellowships, but Fellows will be entitled to free accommodation in Cambridge and round-trip travel from their country to Cambridge. They will also have access to the Woolf Institute and Cambridge University libraries.

The Fellowship is available for a postdoctoral scholar of any academic rank, a policymaker or analyst in a relevant area of work, or an artist (writer, painter, photographer, etc.) and will most likely be asked to participate in some of the Institute's teaching or practice-based activities. 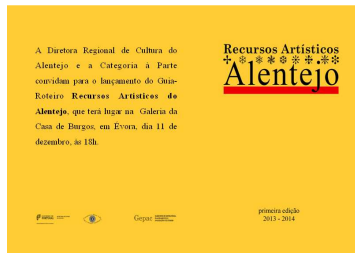

Prémios Científicos / Prizes:

- 1) Association for Spanish and Portuguese Historical Studies - annual A. H. de Oliveira Marques Prize
- The Association for Spanish and Portuguese Historical Studies solicits submissions for the annual A. H. de Oliveira Marques Prize. The A. H. de Oliveira Marques Prize was created by means of a generous endowment from Dr. Harold B. Johnson, University of Virginia, in memory of the distinguished Portuguese historian, A. H. de Oliveira Marques (1933-2007). The prize, which carries an honorarium of \$250, will be awarded each year for the best peer-reviewed article or book chapter on Portuguese history published during the previous year. This year's award will be announced at the 2015 annual meeting of the Association for Spanish and Portuguese History in Baltimore, Maryland. Submitted articles or book chapters may be written in Portuguese, English, Castilian or French, but only articles on Portuguese history published within the 2014 calendar year will be considered. Authors must be active members of the ASPHS to be eligible.
- Authors should submit (1) one electronic copy (via email) and one paper copy of the article or chapter and (2) a short (2-page) CV, including current address, to EACH member of the prize committee below. Submissions must be received by all members of the committee by 31 January 2015.
