3) Call for papers: session 'Singles and the Economy, 1500-1900', 10th Swedish Economic History Meeting (Lund, 4-5 October 2013)

The study of single people in the past has witnessed increased attention in recent years. The two key features of the European Marriage Pattern - late marriages and high celibacy rates - resulted in large numbers of singles in early modern society. In recent research the high incidence of singles has been linked to the specific demographic and economic development that Europe went through since the Middle Ages. The goal of the session is to bring together scholars interested in any aspect of the role of singles in economic development and, conversely, the role of economic development on both the amount and share of singles in a society, and on the ways in which singles coped with economic and social change. Topics include (but are not limited to) the study of the socio-economic background of singles and the decision (or likelihood) to become one, as well as their influence on society, e.g. in terms of limiting the rates of fertility and population pressure, but also their influence on the development of new institutions (e.g. for old-age security), their role in changing investment patterns in human capital and in changes in labour markets, as well as their social and cultural status and material living arrangements.

Scholars interested in presenting their work on the session should write an e-mail, including a one-page abstract and a short cv (in PDF format), to Jacob Weisdorf (e-mail: jacobw@sam.sdu.dk) no later than 1 June 2013.

This online seminar will develop the basic themes, concepts and case studies required to theorize, analyze and practically engage with global, national, regional and local urban heritage sites in comparative perspective. UNESCO's recently passed Historic Urban Landscape recommendations will form an important backdrop to the course. In addition to providing an introduction to the field of urban heritage studies, the course will address several important topics, including UNESCO's Historic Urban Landscape construct, urban heritage tourism, rediscoveries of local forms of modern heritage, grassroots and living forms of heritage, and contested urban heritage and heritage values. In addressing these themes, the course will seek to answer several important questions: What if anything is unique about urban heritage sites? Why are certain forms of urban heritage neglected or overlooked? What are best practices for sustainably developing historic centers and urban heritage landscapes?

Cerdanya's landscape has a singular trait, namely, it's divided by various administrative international and local borders. The willingness to see and manage this landscape as a whole has brought together the Cerdanya County Council, the Community of Cerdagne Villages, the Pyrenees-Mediterranean European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation (EGTC), the Regional National Park of the Catalan Pyrenees and the Landscape Observatory of Catalonia through the project, *El paisatge transfronterer de la Cerdanya* (“Cerdanya's cross-border landscape”). All these administrations and organisations have joined their efforts to establish the foundations with which to raise awareness about this cross-border landscape, seen as the driver behind Cerdanya's development, and with complicity from the area's leading social and economic players.

Thanks to support from Llívia Town Hall and the Government of Catalonia (Casa de Perpinyà) and financing from the EUROCAT project and the Spain-France-Andorra Territorial Cooperation Programme (POCTEFA), these organisations have taken the first step in making this project a reality, publishing a complete booklet to highlight the value of Cerdanya's landscape on both sides of the border and guidelines on the work to be carried out:

The aim of this project is to become a means to familiarise people with this landscape, but, especially, to raise their awareness and commitment, all based on the fact that landscape is a key factor for their own development and strengthens their sense of belonging to a shared space and landscape.
